
The Department of Health has identified 13 priority areas across the state where cesspools pose the greatest threats. The Hui will work together across all priority areas across the state to:

- Discuss new state or county wastewater initiatives & opportunities to submit testimony.
- Share updates on WAI's current projects in the community and/or across the state.
- Discuss ways to overcome a particular community's wastewater setbacks and solutions.
- Discuss innovative systems that could be implemented in each individual priority area.
- Learn about updates on new state or county wastewater initiatives.
- Hear presentations from WAI's partners or local wastewater engineers and contractors.
